

**TOWN OF LONG BEACH  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
OCTOBER 10, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. All council members were present: Robert Angelo, Patrick McDonald, Henry Bausback, Mary Lou McFadden, and Robert Schaefer. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer, Anne Heywood, Police Chief Robert Sulkowski, Town Attorney Jeff Thorne, Volunteer Fire Chief Dave Albers, and Tom Dolph, Street Department. 24 townspeople were present.

**Approval of Minutes:** Henry Bausback motioned to accept the minutes of the council meeting September 12, 2011, second by Mary Lou McFadden.

**REPORTS:**

**Police Department Report:** Chief Sulkowski gave report.

**Police Commission Report:** Robert Schaefer- talked about no overnight parking at Community Center and weekly rentals. Next meeting Nov 2 at 8:30 a.m.

**L.B. Volunteer Fire Department Report:** Dave Albers gave the report.

**Fire Commission Report:** Mary Lou McFadden- No meeting

**Street Department Report:** Tom Dolph gave report – Cutting back trees and brush along the edge of road. Trucks are getting ready for leaf pickup. New Trucks will be ready Mid-November.

**Park Board:** Henry Bausback – No report

**Community Center:** Pat McDonald – Getting prices for the falling overhang by the community center. Thanked the Higdon Family and Civic for carpeting room 12.

**Water Board Report:** Robert Schaefer – Water Board met on September 26, 2011, 8:30 a.m. Talked about putting liens on water/garbage bills. Next meeting is October 24, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

**Building Permit Report:** Anne: September – 15 permits: Construction costs- \$209,400.00; Fees of \$1,450.00 – For September we issued 5 Electrical permits: Costs of \$ 549.00 10% Fees \$ 54.90

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Update on Stop 28 cement deck. Pat McDonald made a motion to repair stop 28. The homeowner, Mr. Leinweber, will donate \$1,500 towards the project and the Town will pay the difference of \$2,082 with the understanding that this project will not exceed the bid of \$3,582. There was discussion. Motion seconded by Bob Schaefer. All approved.
2. Driveway: Steve Hale spoke on behalf of the Kattens; Mr. Arendt also talked. They still had not agreed on anything. Motion made by Henry Bausback that the parties had 15 days to work out something and report back to the town, otherwise Plan A (see attached) would take place. There was discussion. Motion seconded by Bob Schaefer. All approved.
