Minutes from April 18, 2016 Regular Meeting**

Members Present: Maureen Healy, Nick Meyer, Bob LeMay, Richard Jercich and Patrick Cannon.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7PM
2. Roll was taken and the attendees' names are noted above.
3. The minutes of the March 21, 2016 regular meeting were considered. A motion to approve the minutes made by Nick Meyer and seconded by Bob Lemay and the minutes were approved by a vote of 5-0.
4. Subcommittee reports were made:
 - Comprehensive Plan Subcommittee: Patrick Cannon advised the Commission that the subcommittee had conducted its second public meeting on Saturday, April 16, 2016 at the gym of the community center. McKenna & Associates conducted a visioning session. There were approximately 50 residents present and activities conducted by the attendees. It is believed that the results of the visioning session would be available in a couple of weeks. Additionally it was reported that written community surveys had been mailed to all Long Beach Property owners. The survey could be done on paper or could be done via a link given on the correspondence attached to the mailed survey.
 - Nick Meyer made report of the Town Beautification subcommittee. The last meeting was held on April 14, 2016. Items discussed were the agreement by the committee for replacement of the trees around the community center by NIPSCO. It was felt that the trees chosen by the Beautification Committee would be installed by NIPSCO sometime this spring. Second item discussed by the sub-committee was town signage. The committee had made an inventory of the current town signage with a view toward any need for changes or upgrades. The discussion of that issue will continue. Lastly there was discussion with Long Beach Country Club on the issue of replacement of its fencing along Chasleton. The sub-committee was ready to make its suggestions and recommendations with the caveat that since the club was paying for the project the decision would largely be theirs.
 - Report of the Land Preservation Subcommittee. No report.
 - Report of the Immediate Zoning Subcommittee. No report.
5. The meeting was opened for the purposes of Public comments. Bill Powers of 1523 Lakeshore Dr. mentioned that the State of Indiana through its coastal grant program had a meeting scheduled for the 20th of April and he thought it would be a good idea if someone could attend from the town. The word

about the meeting and its location would be circulated. Bill would attend if possible. Jane Neulieb of 2201 Florimond added that her experience with the coastal grant is that it would need to permit public parking spaces to be granted. The comments were duly noted.

6. There was a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Bob LeMay and seconded by Nick Meyer and the motion passed on a vote of 5-0.
