TOWN SIGNAGE

Consensus of the Beautification Committee that the entry sign to the town should be on the west side of Karwick.

Benefits

- would provide an aesthetic balance upon entering the town
- more visible if located on the west side
- would be able to place on an angle, as opposed to running parallel to the fence if placed on the east side of Karwick.
- East side of Karwick already has a sign advertising businesses in Tinker's Dam Professional Office Building, thereby creating a crowded effect.

Beautification Committee would like to hear the Civic Associations viewpoints relating to the placement of the towns entry sign.

Committee feels we should have an 'absolute' on the decision.
