

**Town of Long Beach  
Police Commission Meeting  
August 6, 2014**

**Present: Chief Sulkowski, Val Sliwa, Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer**

- 1. The Chief informed the Commission that the Building Commissioner is writing citations for ordinance violations and using the Police Tickets. He would like to have the Building Commissioner develop a citation which would be specific to the Building Commission so that the Building Commissioner would handle any calls related to the citations.**
- 2. The Chief reported that the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend was uneventful relative to any problems. Everything went well.**
- 3. The Chief will be meeting with the Budget and Finance Committee to begin developing the 2015 budget.**
- 4. A discussion was held regarding the use of the Town's north parking lot. The sign at the lot states it is for residents and their guests, yet ordinance 72.14 allows for nonresidents who can obtain a permit for three hours. This should be brought to the Advisory Planning Commission to review.**
- 5. Bob Schaefer provided a report to the Commission regarding the Police Contracts for Michiana Shores and Duneland Beach. These three year contracts will expire in February 2015. Bob conducted a real time analysis of the amount of time the police provide regular service in those areas, as well as calls that come to the dispatchers. Based upon the analysis, he suggested the following charges:**

| \$55,160               | 2017 (+3%)  | \$49,130              | 2017 (+3%) |

**There was a good deal of discussion among the Commission, audience and police members. Following the discussion, the Commission unanimously approved the above amounts and recommend these to the Town Council for approval.**
