

Long Beach Street Commission Meeting

June 14, 2013

8:30 AM

Members present: Mrs. Anne Robson, Mr. Robert Gallagher, Mr. Bill DeFuniak, Mr. Tom Dolph, and Mr. Patrick McDonald

Items discussed:

1. The possible chance from a part time employee to a full time employee for the Street Dept. was talked about. Mr. De Funiak was going to check into new changes to the laws and report back.
2. The fall leaf pickup was discussed. The dates of starting on October 21, 2013 and ending on December 4, 2013 were picked. Some adjustments to the contract were suggested, and will be presented to the Town's Attorney for review.
3. 2 requests from the Long Beach Fire Dept. were received. One was a request for the Street Dept. to remove fallen trees from the Moon Valley trail so in case of a fire they can get in easier. This was approved and will be done ASAP. The second request was for the right of first refusal if the Street department were to sell their red 4-wheel drive pickup in the near future. Tom said that the Ford dealer guessed the value at about \$6000.00. This information was passed on to the Fire Department for their consideration.
4. A sample MS4 handout was passed out for examination. We hope to have a handout for Long Beach soon.
5. There was discussion about the storm drain work that will be done this summer. A priority list was put together for the work.
6. Tom gave an update on the beach marking signs installation progress. The numbered signs were a donation from The Long Beach Civic Association
7. A bid for a replacement pickup truck was looked at. We are able to purchase this at a Municipal Fleet discount, which is much lower than retail. This will be presented to the Town Board for review.
