Police Advisory Commission Meeting
December 5, 2012

Present: Val Sliwa, Bob Angelo, Chief Bob Sulkowski, Bob Schaefer

1. The Commission discussed the manner in which police officers get paid for unused sick days and unused vacation days. Officers are allowed to “sell back” three unused sick days and 5 unused vacation days. The question arose as to the definition of a “day”. Since a “day” for the officer is 12 hours, they feel that the pay for unused days should be calculated as 12 hours pay, per day, as opposed to a normal 8 hour day. Bob Schaefer will discuss this with Clerk Treasurer Bill deFuniak. He suggested that the Human Resources Committee should investigate this and advise the Police Advisory Commission.
2. As a result of the two former police vehicles being auctioned off, the Town will receive \$10,600 from the sales. The Chief requested that this amount be put towards the Police Department budget for the purchase of new equipment.
3. The department received a donation from the Davis Estate consisting of an AR 15 Assault Weapon and ammo, valued at \$4,000.
4. The Chief has recommended that they forgo participating in the State’s annual breathalyzer training program that costs the department \$650/year. The Commission approved.
