Police Advisory Commission
October 3, 2012
Minutes

1. Bob Schaefer reported that the police contracts for Michiana Shores and Duneland Beach will be presented to the Town Council for their signatures at the October 8th Council meeting. The two year contacts allow for either monthly or quarterly payments to the Town.
2. The Commission finalized the language for use of the Town Center North Parking Lot and this will be provided to Attorney Thorne to amend Ordinance 72.14. The uses are:
 - The lot will be for residents only and their guests. The residents or their guests must go to the dispatcher and provide their address and they will be given a parking permit
 - No permit is needed for Town employees, committee/commission members, fire/police members and people attending Town functions or meetings
 - There are eight designated spaces for business only parking
 - There are two designated spaces for the handicapped
 - There are no hourly time limits
 - The parking lot will be open from 6:00AM to 11:00PM
 - No overnight parking unless approved by the Chief Marshal or his designate
3. The fiber optic project is done and we are waiting to be hooked up for internet and direct connection to the County and other municipal police agencies. There is a cost of \$385/mo. for the maintenance and the Chief is checking to see if the Town needs to pay that.
4. 30 day rentals: The Chief is awaiting the fee schedule that the Plan Commission will be approving.
5. The Chief will be sending violation warning letters to residents that have trailers, boats and water craft parked in their driveways or in public view.
6. Officer Todd Bullis had surgery and will be on light duty for the next 6-8weeks.
7. The two new police cars are in service and we will be auctioning the two replaced vehicles.
8. Next meeting will be November 7th at 8:30AM.
