A dry well maybe needed on Oriole Trail by the park but this will be something for the Water Dept. to assess.

3. Gardener/ Brian Kanyer - Discussion took place on the gardener position. A motion was made to keep Brian Kanyer as the gardener and stated he will be a part time town employee, working up to 20 hours per week during the months of February through November at a salary of \$20.00 per hour. The motion passed.

the community center was discussed.
