I. Call to order

II. Quorum declared: Kendra Bartlett, Pres.; Kathryn De La Barre, Sec.; William Hazelgrove; present. Karin McLinden, V.P. absent. 6 residents were present.

III. The March 23, 2016 regular meeting minutes were unanimously approved.

IV. Old Business

1. Melrose Park - Melrose Park is close to being completed. Equipment has been installed. Fence should be installed next week. Grass has been seeded but not growing well yet. Signage is still needed to state hours and rules. Hoping to be finished and ready to open Memorial weekend. L B Fire Department will participate in official opening. The firemen will bring a truck to Melrose Park and also a snow cone machine.

2. Tennis Court Resurfacing - Kendra received 3 options from Arnt Asphalt ranging from \$5000.00 for basic crack repair, color touch up and cleaning to \$72,300.00 for a total removal of old surface and replacing it with new. Kendra will continue to look for additional companies to bid on this project.

3. Wish List - Kendra emailed the Park Board's wish list to the Civic Association but has not received a response.

V. Summer Park Program - Sarah Plooster - Interviews for counselors are finished. Two new counselors and one substitute have been hired. Orientation for new counselors will be June 17. Advertisement for camp will be in The Beacher the first part of June. Samples presented of business cards, summer camp forms and tennis forms. No t-shirts for campers this year. Staff will have t-shirts. Planning a movie night for July.

VI. New Business

1. Memorial bench request received. This request will be sent to the town

council.

2. Garden Club mulch order has been processed.

3. Replacement rubber mulch for the playground at the Community Center has been ordered.

4. Brian Kanyer will power wash, stain and reposition benches in the park.

5. George Kassal would like to use a room at the Community Center to teach a photography class. Joy will take this request to the Community Center Committee.

6. Karin McLinden is moving and will be unable to continue on the Park Board. If you know of anyone interested in filling this vacancy send their name to Kendra.

Eagle Scouts would like more direction as to where paths should be placed in Moon Valley.
