The following items were discussed:

Building Commissioner's office. We will be meeting with Doug Wickstrom, hopefully this week, to review the two plan ideas to accommodate the space needed for the Building commissioner's office. Security for the Clerk- Treasurer and staff was discussed.

30 day rentals-- letter to the realtors is ready to go! The violation letters will soon make their way through the approval process.

Cameras for town entrances will be costly at this time. We will re-examine this issue when the new county communication system is up.

Community Center Doors are still being found open by the Police. The ancient doors seem to be a bigger problem than human error.

Triathlon expenses will be forwarded to Town Council for consideration when they request a permit. Chief Sulkowski will pull together the costs.

Server updates are on hold until June when the LaPorte county's IT department (Jon Meyer) will be available. The server is shared with the Clerks office and the closest back-up for the CivicSystem is in Niles, MI., which is a concern.

Dispatcher position and 911 calls were discussed. An examination on these positions as well as utilizing the new County 911 system are under review.
