The following items were discussed:

Old business:

Building Commissioner's Office. No decision on plans for this space.

30 Day Rentals- Letters to realtors have been sent out.

Community Center Doors - Are still found to be unlocked. Due to more immediate demands on the Community Center 2017 budget, the doors are not likely to be replaced in the near future. We will continue to rely on the Long Beach Police Dept. to check and secure these doors.

City by the Lake Triathlon- we spoke with Jackie Rowely, Northwest Athletic Club, and she has agreed to pay all town expenses incurred by this event. She expressed her gratitude to the town and will attend the June Town Council meeting to get final approval.

Server update- Chief Sulkowski and Council President, Pete Byvoets met with Jon Meyer, LaPorte County IT Department. A back-up server located at the Community Center was discussed. We will get pricing from LaPorte vs. our present company, to determine the best avenue for the town. It was determined that a back-up generator was not needed.

New Business

The current sign ordinance was briefly discussed due to complaints involving the signage in the town. Particularly, the huge developer signs. A complete overhaul of our existing ordinance needs to be done. We will begin to research this immediately.
