Old Business

Community's Center doors were all found open as well as evidence that person/persons were in the building after hours. The Police will check all the footage on the security cameras.

Building Commissioners office has been moved to the Community Center. The partitions have been removed from the Town Hall.

30 Day Rental Advisory letters and citations will now become part of the police report at Town Council Meetings.

New Business

Outdoor Advertising - The Supreme Court has handed down new Free Speech guidelines for municipal sign regulation. This effects all signs. We will begin the process to change our ordinances to conform with this ruling.

Entrance to the Town Hall- The deterioration of the entrance concrete was discussed. We would like to see the Town logo in tiles in this area. Funding for this is being explored.

Police Computers- Chief Sulkowski has requested new computers for the police. An estimated cost would be \$3000. Pete will present this expenditure to council for approval next week.
