

Minutes for the Police Commission April 6, 2016

In attendance: Peter Byvoets, Barbara Morgan, Chief Sulkowski, one resident

Absent: Jane Neulieb

The following items were discussed:

- 2 plans for the new Building Commissioner's office are being reviewed. It was agreed that the Commissioner should be in the Town Hall and not at the Community Center.
- Short Term Rentals (less than 30 days) were discussed. Letters to inform realtors will be sent out the week of April 18. The advertising portion of our code needs to be placed under an ordinance. Pete to discuss this with HWL. When Chief Sulkowski returns from vacation(4/18) we will institute the complete procedure that will get the citations to court.
- The 2 new Police cars are in service
- The security cameras are fully functional in the Town Hall, but not yet at the Community Center.
- The total cost for cameras at Town entrances has not been determined.
- Police are still finding doors at the Community Center open at night.
- Additional \$\$ from the Triathlon group are needed to defray expenses incurred to control traffic.
- The security gate for the Street Dept. on Karwick/Chaselton rd. Received an estimate of \$11,000. We will try just locking the present gate at night and on weekends. Street Dept. staff will all be given keys.
- The new county wide communication system will be available at the earliest in August. It will be functional when the new Michigan CityPolice station is completed. There will be no cost to the town for this new equipment
- Jon Meyer, of the LaPorte County IT dept. suggested that the town should update their servers and back up equipment. We will investigate this with Mr. Meyer.
- Golf Cart registration was discussed. Chief Sulkowski will develop mandatory safety requirements and we will proceed to the Town Council for approval.
