TOWN COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING 5/18/15  
6:30 P.M.

Attending were Council President Robert Schaefer and councilpersons Jane Neulieb, Peter Byvoets, Robert Angelo and Patrick McDonald. Also present was Clerk-Treasurer Bill de Funiak and Town Marshal Bob Sulkowski. Four residents attended. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

Bob Sulkowski presented 3 bids for repair, sealcoating and striping of the Town parking lot. Bids were received from Rieth-Riely, Arnt and Pro-Drive. After review of the scope of the bids, motion was made, seconded and unanimously approved to select Arnt for the project. The winning bid was \$7,960.00 (check this).

Pat McDonald presented the bid from Austin Masonry to replace damaged sidewalk behind the Town Hall (\$1,100) and to replace the pillar at Stop 26 (\$4,500). Austin has the mold for the concrete on top of the brick pillar. Motion to proceed with Austin was made, seconded and approved unanimously.

McDonald related that a local excavation firm has offered to sink steel supports for the Stop 29 stairs at no charge to the town. Original bidder, CL Builders, has been selected to perform the completion of the Stop 29 stairs.

Ordinance fees/fines workshop has been scheduled for 1 PM on Wednesday, May 27, 2015.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM.
