LONG BEACH STREET COMMISSION MEETING

March 30, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 A.M.

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

OLD BUSINESS:

It was agreed that the previous fall leaf pick up went well, and the system seems to be working.

NEW BUSINESS:

Spring leaf pick up. After discussion it was decided that the spring pick up would be outsourced. The dates for collection were determined to be Monday thru Friday, April 27<sup>th</sup> to Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. There will be 1 pass through the town. Your leaves need to be at the curb by April 26<sup>th</sup>. They are NOT to be in the street. Any leaves put out after an area is picked up will be the responsibility of the home owner to dispose of.

It was agreed to allocate up to \$5,000.00 for the purchase of precast cement blocks for a salt storage facility foundation at a date to be determined.

Mr. Dolph suggested that 2 drain grates be installed on tank hill, and other storm drains be raised up.

The transportation and repair of the Cat 416 backhoe was approved.

It was OK'd for Mr. Dolph to start looking into a replacement front end loader to replace the existing unit because of its age and amount of usage.

In order to stay compliant, a flammable liquid storage cabinet purchase was approved. A local manufacturer was located, thus eliminating any shipping charges.

Street striping and repaving will be put out for estimates. Mr. Dolph will get the bids.
