

LONG BEACH STREET COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

After the welcome the following topics were discussed:

The last fall leaf pick up. It was decided that it went well, but will need some minor adjustments for next year.

Equipment update: Tom's pickup truck will have to be replaced soon. We hope with the lack of snow this year that a better price might be available on a new unit.

The Park Board OK'd replacing their mower and this will go to the Town Board on Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> for the final OK.

The Street Dept. is looking into a storage facility that can hold apprx. 400 tons of salt. This will bring us in line with state requirements.

New Federal guide lines will require us to replace almost all the street signs in the Town. This will happen over several years. We have appx. \$5,000.00 in the budget this year to start.

The Street Dept is trying to put together a Storm Water Runoff pamphlet to hand out with building permits. This will remind people to be careful of what can end up in the streets.
