SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
AUGUST 21, 2015

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:30 A.M. BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT ROBERT SCHAEFER, WHO WAS PRESENT ALONG WITH COUNCILPERSONS PETER BYVOETS, PATRICK MCDONALD, JANE NEULIEB, BOB ANGELO, AND CLERK-TREASURER BILL DE FUNIAK.
