

Long Beach Street Commission Minutes
Wednesday January 17th, 2018

Members present: Tom Dolph, Jane Neulieb, Dan Tannas

Meeting came to order at 5:30 PM

Mr. Dolph reports that snow removal is proceeding normally. Only minor and routine maintenance has been required on equipment.

Street Commission members have been invited to attend a public meeting of the Parks Department on February 28 at 6 PM. Planning and coordination of work on beach stops will be on the agenda.

Road salt supply is adequate so far this season. There was heavy usage between Christmas and New Year's Day, along with a delivery delay; in such periods there is a concern that the town might not have an adequate supply. Because of possible shortages and the expense of storage, Long Beach may need to discontinue the supply of salt to Trail Creek and Duneland Beach. The Street Commission will make a recommendation to the Town Board at its February meeting.

The town's drainage pipe located at 1636 Lakeshore Drive will be shortened as soon as spring weather permits. Additional pipe is the homeowner's responsibility and must be handled by a private contractor. Mr. Dolph has agreed to follow up and assist the homeowner with a recommendation.
