

LONG BEACH STREET COMMISSION MINUTES  
Wednesday August 16<sup>th</sup> 5:30 PM

Members present: Tom Dolph, Brian Hogan, Jane Neulieb, Dan Tannas. Called to order 5:30.

Townspeople present: None

1. Future plans for Indiana Dot matching grants: Mr. Dolph will coordinate with Haas and Associates to be sure paperwork is in order for grant requests.
2. Paving plans: the long-term plan is subject to frequent revision due to construction/utility road cuts and emergency drainage repairs. Re-paving is deferred to wait for road cuts to be completed. Paving projects are now done in accordance with a grading scale to prioritize each segment depending on condition and urgency. At this time the following are under consideration: Parkside near Stop 20, Roslyn east of Belle Plaine, patching on Lawndale. At the present time no action will be taken on the park/street area at Oriole and Juneway.

To stay within budget constraints, the Community Center parking lot project will be looked at after other repairs and re-paving are completed. Mr. Dolph will research the location of drainage tanks under the parking lot entry, then re-configure the entry off Oriole Trail to improve the one-way access to the Community Center driveway and parking areas. Because of the one-way traffic flow in the driveway, a stop sign at Oriole will be unnecessary.

After recent heavy rains, a sinkhole has appeared adjacent to the manhole at Oriole and St. Lawrence. Repair will require replacement of approximately 90 feet of underground drainage pipe. The preliminary estimate is for \$8750 and work should begin in a few days. The repair will be left in crushed-stone and allowed to settle before re-paving and completion. This is an emergency repair and is already in the street department budget.

3. Leaf pickup schedule will be determined at the September meeting. The new machine is scheduled for delivery in time for the fall pickup.
4. A drainage problem at the intersection of Oriole/Lothair/Shady Oak has been successfully repaired.
5. Approved Mr. Dolph to purchase additional plastic barricades, traffic cones and obstruction barrels which can be stored indefinitely. This will avoid repeated labor and repair for wooden barricades used at repairs, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, etc. This item already budgeted for signage.
