THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:45 P.M. THIS MEETING WAS ANNOUNCED AT THE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING SEPTEMBER 12, 2016. PETER BYVOETS, NICK MEYER, JANE NEULIEB, BOB LE MAY, CLERK-TREASURER BILL DE FUNIAK, AND STREET SUPT. TOM DOLPH WERE PRESENT; COUNCILPERSON JOY SCHMITT WAS ABSENT. 3 PEOPLE ATTENDED THIS MEETING.

BOB LEMAY ENTERED A MOTION TO AWARD THE PAVING CONTRACT (BIDS WERE OPENED AT THE SEPTEMBER 12TH COUNCIL MEETING) TO RIETH-RILEY AND TO RETURN THE BID BOND TO WALSH & KELLY. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY JANE NEULIEB. DISCUSSION FOLLOWED AND SUPT. DOLPH EXPLAINED THAT THE RIETH-RILEY BID WAS \$175,750.00 INCLUDING STREET STRIPING. WALSH & KELLY'S BID WAS \$175,500 PLUS AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR STRIPING WHICH WAS COMPUTED IN EXCESS OF \$180,000.00
MOTION TO APPROVE THE PAVING CONTRACT TO RIETH-RILEY WAS APPROVED 4 – 0.
