

**Town of Long Beach
Police Advisory Commission Meeting
August 7, 2013**

Commissioners present: Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer, Val Sliwa, Todd Bullis for Chief Marshal Sulkowski

Acting Chief Marshal Todd Bullis brought up the following:

The department received the new camera, the cost of which (\$4,900) was approved by the Council at the July meeting. He indicated that he was able to secure \$3,400 of the cost from the County Prosecutor's office.

The department needs a new radar unit that will cost \$1,700. This amount is in the department's budget; however, since it is over \$1,000 it will need Council approval.

There have been some recent calls to the department over people parking on the Town's right of way, where the home owner feels that it is their property. Some homeowners are putting up chains, large rocks and no parking signs on the Town rights of way which is adjacent to their property. Officer Bullis would like some direction on how the department should respond to these calls. How should the Town enforce this? Mr. Schaefer will put it on the Council agenda to discuss.

There has been more evidence of contractors parking on the Town's roadways while servicing homes for various reasons. They have large trucks and trailers that partially block the roads. He will develop a plan to address this issue for next year.

Todd is working with the Budget and Finance Committee on the department's 2014 budget.

Todd mentioned that Chief Marshal Sulkowski will be returning to work in mid August.

The Commission discussed the Tort Claim that was filed on July 30th by Dalia Wendt against the Town, Town Council, the Police Advisory Commission and the Police Department for "multiple acts of trespass on the private property of Mrs. Wendt by the Town of Long Beach Police Department and its police officers, by driving the ATV's onto and across their private property". This will be referred to the Town Attorney.

The Commission expressed thanks to Acting Chief Marshal Todd Bullis for his service during the absence of Chief Marshal Sulkowski.
