Police Advisory Commission Meeting  
November 6, 2013

Present: Bob Schaefer, Val Sliwa, Chief Marshal Sulkowski

1. Chief Marshal Sulkowski informed the Commission that new officer Jason Speakman will be participating in the state Police Academy's physical agility testing. Following this, he will attend the state Police Academy for 16 weeks.
2. The Commission discussed the Town right of way use issue. Bob reported that attorney Julie Paulson had researched the issue and sent information to him. Use of a town's right of way varies from town to town. A town can develop a specific ordinance regarding use of the right of way. The Planning Commission should look into this and report to the Council.
3. The Commission discussed the annual Triathlon Race that includes part of Long Beach. The Town receives a request each year to allow the race to come into the Town. The Chief Marshal estimated that it costs the Town \$2500 in extra manpower, including police and street department personnel. It is costly, it closes down Lake Shore Drive and it does present some safety issues. The Council may want to address this when the request is presented again this year.
