Police Advisory Commission Meeting  
October 2, 2013

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Present: Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer, Val Sliwa, Chief Bob Sulkowski

1. The full time dispatcher will be leaving in a few weeks. The Commissioners discussed using part time dispatchers instead of replacing that position with a full time person. The Chief will work on a replacement plan and will bring it to the next meeting.
2. There is a need to upgrade the connection between the police equipment (security alarms, etc.) in the basement of the Town Hall and the vault located on the hill by the water tower. The chief will look into the installation of a fiber optic line between the two.
3. The Commissioners discussed the yearly problem of items left on the beach after the summer. Historically, the street department picks up the items and takes them to the Town garage area. The Commissioners felt that perhaps there should be a fine covering the time it takes to haul and store the items before the items can be given back to the residents. December 1<sup>st</sup> is the last day for items to be removed from the beach areas. This is an item that should be put in a newsletter to residents.
4. Speeding on Town streets was brought up at September's Council meeting. The Chief will discuss this with the officers.
