

**Town of Long Beach
Police Commission Meeting
January 7, 2015**

Members present: Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer, Val Sliwa, Chief Marshal Bob Sulkowski

1.All members agreed to serve on the Commission for 2015.

2.Bob Schaefer indicated that the Police contracts for Michiana Shores and Duneland Beach have not been returned to the Town by both of those communities. Both contracts end January 31, 2015. Chief Sulkowski was contacted by a member of the Duneland Beach Association who requested that their contract consist of 5 years, instead of three. The Commission voted to keep it at three years.

3.Officer Jason Yagelski has completed his initial year on the Police Force. Chief Sulkowski recommended a \$2,000 increase in Jason's salary, effective January 1. The Commission approved and recommend that the Council approve. The salary would go from \$43,264 to \$45,264.

4.The Commission discussed the Long Beach Town Center parking lot. Currently, the sign posted there limits the parking to residents and their guests; however, the Ordinance 72.14 states that the lot is available to the public for 3 hours and to residents and their guests for periods in excess of 3 hours. In both cases, a permit to park is required. The Commission recommends that the Ordinance be changed to: (A) The Town Center North Parking Lot shall be available for parking by Town residents and their guests and will be available for parking in designated parking spots for handicapped and neighboring business clients. (B) Any use of the Town Center Parking Lot requires a parking permit issued by the Town.
