Police Commission Meeting
October 1, 2014**

Present: Officer Jim Schooley for Chief Sulkowski, Val Sliwa, Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer

- 1. Ed Sulkowski, Bob's father, passed away. He was the Town's dog warden for many years.**
- 2. There was a discussion regarding the status of the house break ins. Officer Schooley informed the commissioners that the blood samples from the intruder taken from the scene came back from the State Laboratory with no match. The State's system will automatically keep checking for a match.**
- 3. The commissioners discussed having the police check the doors at the Community Center during the evening hours.**
- 4. There was a discussion about having the police check and report on street light outages. These need to be reported to NIPSCO.**
- 5. Officer Schooley reported that the county-wide Interact Software system for all county police departments is on hold. This system would allow for officers to complete reports in their cars and be part of a county wide reporting system.**
- 6. There was a discussion about traffic control on Lake Shore Drive. The speed limit is 25 MPH and Officer Schooley felt that is appropriate. The police do monitor speed on LSD. The commissioners are not in favor of speed bumps or additional stop signs. The idea of having a traffic study was discussed. Bob Schaefer will see if Purdue North Central has someone to conduct this as a project.**
