Police Advisory Commission Meeting
September 4, 2013**

Commissioners Present: Bob Angelo, Bob Schaefer, Val Sliwa

- I. Chief Sulkowski mentioned that Officer Toby Babcock and Reserve Officers Tim Radtke and Hayden David received commendations from Governor Pence relative to their rescue efforts of the young boy at Mount Baldy.**
- II. Chief Sulkowski informed the Commission that there will be an observance for Dispatcher Paul Schreve who passed away recently. Paul served as a dispatcher for the Town for 19 years.**
- III. There have been four recent burglaries in the Town and the Chief has reached out to tell residents to be vigilant and report questionable activities in their neighborhoods.**
- IV. The department has completed the budget process for 2014.**
- V. The Commission discussed the 30 day Rental Ordinance once again. It was unanimously agreed that the ordinance is very difficult to enforce and that the Town has ordinances that cover the items people complain about, such as, noise, parking, litter, etc. The Commission would like the Planning Commission to review it and decide whether to rescind it altogether or keep it and be flexible about the enforcement.**
